WHAT IS AN OPIOID?

Opioids are a class of drug used to reduce pain.

There are three types:

1. Prescription Opioids

Buprenorphine	Codeine
Hydrocodone	Hydromorphone
Methadone	Morphine
Oxycodone	Oxymorphone

2. Heroin - illegal & highly addictive opioid

3. Synthetic Opioids (Man-made)

Fentanyl - 50 times more potent than heroin
Carfentanyl - Elephant Tranquilizer

- You can hear gurgling sounds or snoring
- Skin feels cold & clammy
- Lips & nails are blue
- Pupils are small
